Why is this important?

- Pneumocystis Pneumonia (PCP) is the most common opportunistic infection in people with HIV.
- It is one of HAB's clinical indicators for medical providers.
- Quality data are needed to effectively evaluate care.

Why is this important? (cont.)

Ryan White providers who are funded for Outpatient/Ambulatory Medical Care are required to report whether PCP Prophylaxis was prescribed on their Ryan White Services Report (RSR).

The HIV Care Program (HCP)—the state's Ryan White Part B program—requires PCP Prophylaxis data to be entered in ARIES.

HCP monitors these data in their annual site visits.

Quality Management

...Continued

The target set by OA for Measure 3 is that 75% of HCP clients with HIV infection and a CD4 T-Cell count below 200 cells/mm³ should have been prescribed *Pneumocystis pneumonia* (PCP) prophylaxis during the fiscal year. For ARIES County Public Health Department, 70.0% of eligible HCP clients met this measure compared to 34.7% statewide.

The target set by OA for Measure 12a is that 75% of HCP clients with AIDS should have been prescribed Highly Active Antiretroviral Therapy (HAART) during the fiscal year. For ARIES County Public Health Department, 100.0% of eligible HCP clients met this measure compared to 84.4% statewide.

Entering PCP Prophylaxis data

Begin by searching for the client record.

When entering PCP Prophylaxis data...

Select the appropriate medication from the list box that appears as you type in the medication's name in the "Other Medications" field.

- Type in exactly "PCP" in the "Used for" field.
- Select "Prophylaxis" in the Type field.
- If entering dosage, use the "Dosage" field, not the "Other Medications" field.

When entering PCP Prophylaxis data...(cont.)

Verify first that there is a CD4 test below 200 entered on the Medical History Screen



When entering PCP Prophylaxis data...(cont.)

 Verify first that there is an Outpatient/Ambulatory Medical Care service entered for the client on the Services screen

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Cleaning up PCP Prophylaxis data...

We hope these guidelines help improve data quality moving forward.
Some of your records may need attention. We have designed a fix-it report that may be missing PCP Prophylaxis information.

The Fix-It PCP Prophylaxis Report

We will now demonstrate how to run the PCP Prophylaxis Fix-it Report.
This report will list your clients served within a specified date range along with specific error messages that relate to PCP Prophylaxis.

To locate the **Fix-It: PCP Prophylaxis** report, go to Reports and select the **Client** menu.



The **Fix-It: PCP Prophylaxis** report is located at the bottom of the Client report page.

<u>Clients on ART Medications</u> <u>Fix-It: Proof of Income and</u> <u>Residency</u> <u>Client Name and Primary Staff</u>	The date range filter selects clients who had a service within the period. For the End Date filter, select "Is Null" this means the report only counts the client if the client is still taking the drug. To count clients if they have EVER taken the drug, leave the End Date filter blank. Lists clients served within a date range and whether there are Proof of Income and Proof of Residency Eligibility Documents at ANY agency not more than 6 months old. Expiration based on TODAY's date, not end date of reporting period. Lists clients in alphabetical order with the client's primary staff person. For Display Order filter, select "=" from the dropdown, then enter "1" in the first criteria field.
<u>Fix-It: CD4</u>	Lists clients served within a date range and any problems with CD4 tests
Fix-It: Viral Load	Lists clients served within a date range and any problems with Viral Load tests
Fix-It: HOPWA	Lis Click on "Fix-It: PCP Prophylaxis"
Fix-It: PCP Prophylaxis	Lists clients served within a date range and any problems with PCP Prophylaxis

Click on the report to run. Input your specified dates on the Report Filter Value page.

Fix-It: PCP Prophylaxis Report Error Message

	Message	Meaning
	No PCP Prophylaxis	 There were no Other Medications entered for a client who received a OAMC/MCWP service and had a CD4 below 200 during report time frame that met all of the following criteria: Covers some portion of the last year from the "Run Date" of the report, Contains one of the following medications/drug codes: Bactrim (TMP/SMX)/d00124, Dapsone/d00098, Nebupent (pentamidine)/d00030, or Mepron (atovaquone)/d01120, Had "PCP" entered in the Used for field, and Had "Prophylaxis" entered in the Type field.
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Fix-It: Insurance Report Suggestions Messages

Message	Meaning
Check Used For/Type	A record with correct dates and correct drug code was found, but <u>either</u> the Used For is not "PCP" <u>or</u> the Type is not "Prophylaxis"
Check Drug Code	A record with correct dates, correct Used For, and correct Type was found, but the drug code is d99999 ("Other" drug) and the manually entered drug name is similar to one of drug names mentioned above

IMPORTANT: These messages are <u>not</u> errors. Rather, they suggest there are incomplete data <u>if</u> <u>the client is in fact on PCP Prophylaxis</u>. Please confirm that the client is on PCP Prophylaxis before updating their ARIES record per these messages.

Next Steps

- Please run the report.
 Look up the clients with error messages using their ARIES ID.
- Locate and gather the necessary documents referenced in the Error and/or Suggestions message(s).
 Then update ARIES accordingly.
