

# Medication Assisted Therapy (MAT) Report

## MAT Report Background

In 2018, three questions about MAT were added to the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Services Report (RSR) Provider Report: 1) How many staff members are licensed to prescribe MAT? 2) How many staff members prescribed MAT? and 3) How many clients received MAT? MAT includes the use of medications such as Buprenorphine, Naltrexone, or Methadone to treat opioid dependence. An ARIES MAT report was added in 2019 to help agencies with the third question. This MAT report has been updated for 2021.

Please note entering MAT data in ARIES is not required. The updated MAT report is intended only to help agencies who entered MAT data into ARIES to complete the RSR Provider Report. For agencies who want to begin entering MAT data into ARIES, simply enter Other Medication or Service records meeting the criteria further described below. Please remember that if a client stops taking MAT (or any other drug), agencies need to return to the Other Medications screen and enter an End Date for that medication. Otherwise, ARIES will assume that the client is continuing to take the medication.

## MAT Report Instruction

While the old report looked at only records in the Other Medications section of the client record (subtab of the Medications tab), the updated report also looks at Services in two different ways. First, a client must have had at least one service during the reporting period to be counted in the MAT report. Second, the updated report also looks for drug dispensing services that represent qualifying MAT medications. In addition, a detail report has been added, which lists clients included in the summary report.

To run the updated MAT report, select “Management” from the Reports menu in ARIES, and on the Management Reports page, run the report called “*RSR Provider Report for 2021 – Clients on MAT – Summary*” near the bottom of the page. Note that this report is unique to the 2021 reporting period, so you must use the following filters:

The report is very simple, and will look like the sample report below:

The client list report is called “*RSR Provider Report for 2021 – Clients on MAT– Client List*” and is also located near the bottom of the Management Reports page. Use the same filters as the summary report shown above. The client list report is much like a “Fix-It” report. It lists all clients served during the reporting period, and those with MAT will be shown at the top of the report with the word “MAT” next to their name. If the “MAT” column is blank for a client, that means the client did not receive MAT.

To be included on either report, a client must have the following:

1. A service of any type within 2021.
2. Either of the following:
  - a. An Other Medications record that covers some portion of 2021 with any one of the following:
    - The text “MAT” or “Medication Assisted Therapy” is found in the Used For field.
    - The Drug Code of: d00050, d00311, d00840, d03676, d04819, d07394, or d07472.
    - The Drug Name field, whether manually entered (i.e., Other Drug) or selected from the dropdown that starts with one of the following: ReVia, Evzio, Depade, Narcan, Nalone, Zubsolv, Subutex, Vivitrol, Bunavail, Naloxone, Suboxone, Prenoxad, Narcanti, Narcotan, Sublocade, Methadone, Methadose, Dolophine, Naltrexone, Buprenorphine.
  - b. A service record within 2021 that contains a drug dispensing with either of the following:
    - The Drug Code of: d00050, d00311, d00840, d03676, d04819, d07394, or d07472.
    - The Drug Name field, whether manually entered (i.e., Other Drug) or selected from the dropdown that starts with one of the following: ReVia, Evzio, Depade, Narcan, Nalone, Zubsolv, Subutex, Vivitrol, Bunavail, Naloxone, Suboxone, Prenoxad, Narcanti, Narcotan, Sublocade, Methadone, Methadose, Dolophine, Naltrexone, Buprenorphine.
